A meeting of the Montoursville Area School District Board of School Directors was held on August 11, 2015 in the Auditorium of the Montoursville Area High School, 100 North Arch Street, Montoursville, PA 17754. The president, Thomas P. McNamara, called the meeting to order at 8:00 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The president, Mr. McNamara, presented the minutes of the July 14, 2015 regular board meeting for approval and announced the minutes would be approved as presented if no objections or corrections were noted. There being no objections or corrections noted the minutes were approved as presented.

The president, Mr. McNamara, announced public comments would be received at the beginning of the meeting. The solicitor, Mr. Holland, explained that this public comment period would be for comments directly related to items on the meeting agenda, then reviewed the parameters for the public comment period. Mr. Paul Rinker, Mr. Ron Snell, and Ms. Amy Norton commented on the approval of the Montoursville Area High School Additions and Renovations project.

PRESNTATION

Dr. Bowers introduced Mr. Paul Taylor and Mr. Scott Cousin of Crabtree, Rohrbaugh and Associates Architects. Mr. Scott Cousin reviewed the a tabulation of the base bids and alternate bids opened on July 23, 2015 for the Montoursville Area High School Additions and Renovations project. Then Mr. Cousin provided a description of each of the bid alternates being recommended by the administration for the school board's consideration of approval. Afterward, Mr. Cousin answered questions from the school board related to the recommended alternates. Next, Mr. Paul Taylor reviewed in detail the Pennsylvania Department of Education PlanCon Part F Attachment C and PlanCon Part G documents. Finally, Mr. Taylor answered questions from the school board and public regarding the Montoursville Area High School Additions and Renovations project.

Presentation regarding the Montoursville Area High School Additions and Renovations project Dr. Bowers presented a recommendation from the supplemental agenda for the approval of the Montoursville Area High School Additions and Renovations PlanCon Part F Attachment C document and authorized **Crabtree**, **Rohrbaugh and Associates** to submit the document to the **PA Department of Education** for review and approval. A motion was made by Mr. Ulmer and seconded by Mr. Konkle to approve the recommendation. The president, Mr. McNamara called for a roll call vote, Mr. Bergen, yes; Mr. Hagemeyer, no; Mrs. Kaplan, no; Mr. Konkle, yes; Mrs. Marriott, yes; Mr. McNamara, yes; and Mr. Ulmer, yes; the motion carried.

Approval to submit PDE PlanCon documentation

The solicitor, Mr. Holland, recommended that the board authorize any representative of **Pennoni Associates Inc.** to sign and return a letter to concur to conditions imposed by the **Montoursville Borough Council** regarding conditional approval of the Alternate Final Land Development Plan for the Montoursville Area High School. A motion was made by Mr. Ulmer and seconded by Mrs. Marriott to approve the solicitor's recommendation. All members present voted yes, except Mr. Hagemeyer voting no, the motion carried.

Approval to authorize Pennoni Associates, Inc. to issue letter

Dr. Bowers presented a recommendation from the supplemental agenda for approval to award bids for the Montoursville Area High School Additions and Renovations project to the lowest responsible bidders, authorize Crabtree, Rohrbaugh and Associates to issue letters of intent to award, generate construction contracts, and issue notices to proceed, and authorize the School Board President or Vice-President to sign contacts after review by Administration and legal counsel; all contingent upon PlanCon Part F and Part G approvals by the Pennsylvania Department of Education: 1. General Construction contract to Lobar, Inc. including alternates GC-6, GC-7, GC-10, GC-11, GC-13, and GC-17; 2. HVAC Construction contract to The Farfield Company including alternates HC-1c and HC-3; 3. Plumbing Construction contract to Silvertip, Inc.; 4. Electrical Construction contract to Lecce Electric, Inc. alternates EC-9, EC-10, EC-11, EC-12, and EC-13; 5. Roofing Construction contract to Weatherproofing Technologies, Inc., and 6. HVAC Controls contract to NRG Controls North, Inc. A motion was made by Mr. Ulmer and seconded by Mr. Konkle to approve the recommendation. The president, Mr. McNamara called for a roll call vote, Mr. Bergen, yes; Mr. Hagemeyer, no; Mrs. Kaplan, no; Mr. Konkle, yes; Mrs. Marriott, yes; Mr. McNamara, yes; and Mr. Ulmer, yes; the motion carried.
