December 7, 2015 BOARD MEETING MINUTES

A meeting of the Montoursville Area School District Board of School Directors was held on December 7, 2015 in the Auditorium of the Montoursville Area High School, 100 North Arch Street, Montoursville, PA 17754. The president, Ronald E. Snell, called the meeting to order immediately following an organizational board meeting, at 8:15 p.m.

Call to Order

The president, Mr. Snell announced to forego the roll call and flag salute for this meeting.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The president, Mr. Snell, presented the minutes of the November 10, 2015 regular board meeting. A motion was made by Mr. Kaplan and seconded by Mr. Hagemeyer to approve the minutes of the November 10, 2015 regular board meeting. All members present voted yes, the motion carried.

Approval of minutes

MEETING AGENDA REVISION

A motion was made by Mr. Snell and seconded by Mr. McCleary, to revise the agenda to include the building project and discuss a change in the Montoursville Area School District Solicitor. All members present voted yes, except Mr. Konkle, Mrs. Marriott, and Mr. Ruffing voting no, the motion carried.

Approve agenda revision

PRIOR PRESENTATION

The President, Mr. Snell, presented a recognition plaque on behalf of the Montoursville Area School District to Mrs. Dora Pioli for her service to the District as board member and employee. Mrs. Jill Kaplan presented flowers to Dora on behalf of all of the 5 Common Sense Candidates.

Prior presentations

First Christian Church of Montoursville Pastor Bob Hine, representing the Montoursville Ministerium, addressed the Board of School Directors and offered his blessings to the District.

PUBLIC COMMENT

The president, Mr. Snell, announced public comments would be received at the beginning of the meeting and reviewed the parameters for the public comment period. Ms. Renee Carey expressed her concerns with halting the current building project and encouraged the board to explore the ramifications before halting the project; Ms. Mathers congratulated the new board members and shared her concerns for stopping the building project; Ms. Carrie Pauling shared that she hoped the new board would "make good decisions that benefit the students; Ms. Jami Cordell conveyed she moved to the district for a good education for her kids and was concerned about the board's future decisions; Ms. Pamela Nelson conveyed her desire to move forward together and find solutions that would make the district better; Ms. Danielle Smith shared her concerns about what would happen to the wood, metal and agricultural shop students since equipment was removed from the old shops, but had not been moved to the newly constructed building; and Ms. Cheyenne Wood conveyed she learned as much from extra-curricular activities as she did regular education and hoped the board would approve the agenda items for FBLA.

Public comment

A motion was made by Mr. Kaplan and seconded by Mr. McCleary to change the school board solicitor to **Benjamin Landon**, **Esq**. of the firm McNerney, Page, Vanderlin, and Hall at an hourly rate of \$150.00. The President, Mr. Snell, called for a roll call vote on the motion. Mr. Hagemeyer, yes; Mrs. Johns, yes; Mr. Kaplan, yes; Mr. Konkle, no; Mr. Logue, yes; Mrs. Marriott, no; Mr. McCleary, yes; Mr. Ruffing, no; and Mr. Snell, yes, the motion carried. Mr. Landon assumed the seat of the Solicitor.

Approval of new school board Solicitor

Mr. Holland departed the meeting at this time, 8:39 p.m.

A motion was made by Mr. McCleary and seconded by Mr. Hagemeyer to hire **Bassett Engineering** and its team of professionals to conduct a value engineering study of the high school project at an estimated cost set at \$60,000.00 and all Montoursville Area School District employees shall give their full cooperation to the team, allowing the team full access to all areas of school properties. The President, Mr. Snell, called for a roll call vote on the motion. Mr. Hagemeyer, yes; Mrs. Johns, yes; Mr. Kaplan, yes; Mr. Konkle, no; Mr. Logue, yes; Mrs. Marriott, no; Mr. McCleary, yes; Mr. Ruffing, no; and Mr. Snell, yes, the motion carried.

Approval to engage Bassett Engineering

A motion was made by Mrs. Johns and seconded by Mr. McCleary to temporarily suspend any and all construction of the new three story building, to stop any demolition of the existing high school structures, and to halt all acquisition and/or delivery of materials and equipment until further action by the board, with the only exception to the suspension being the winterization of the present structures and finishing work on the new tech building and all work shall be approved by Bassett Engineering before being done. All members present voted yes, except Mr. Konkle, Mrs. Marriott and Mr. Ruffing voting no, the motion carried.

Approval of temporary suspension to high school project

A motion was made by Mr. Logue and seconded by Mr. Hagemeyer that effective immediately, the board rescind the Montoursville Area School District administration's ability to approve change orders for the high school construction project and designate that change orders for construction must be approved by the school board president and/or the chairman of the buildings and grounds committee. All members present voted yes, except Mr. Konkle, Mrs. Marriott and Mr. Ruffing voting no, the motion carried.

Approve revision to change order approval process

A motion was made by Mr. Hagemeyer and seconded by Mr. McCleary to form an academic evaluation team headed up by **Mrs. Jill Kaplan**, who is volunteering her time, and all Montoursville Area School District employees shall give her and her team their full cooperation and allow her full access to all areas of school properties. All members present voted yes, except Mr. Konkle, Mrs. Marriott and Mr. Ruffing voting no, the motion carried.

Approve academic evaluation team

TREASURER'S REPORT AND PAYMENT OF INVOICES

Mr. Kunze presented a recommendation for the approval of treasurer's reports for the General Fund and Cafeteria Fund for the month ending November 30, 2015; as well as approval of payment of invoices for the General Fund, Cafeteria Fund, and Capital Project Fund for the period ending November 30, 2015. A motion was made by Mr. Snell and seconded by Mr. Hagemeyer to vote separately on each fund. All members present voted yes, except Mr. Konkle, Mrs. Marriott and Mr. Ruffing voting no, the motion carried.

Treasurer's Reports and Payment of Invoices

A motion was made by Mr. Snell and seconded by Mr. Hagemeyer for the approval of the General Fund invoices for the period ending November 30, 2015. During discussions, Mr. Kaplan made a request to table check number 49606 for further review. A motion was made by Mr. Snell and seconded by Mr. Kaplan to withdraw the initial motion to approve the General Fund invoices. A motion was made by Mr. Snell and seconded by Mr. McCleary to pay all General Fund invoices with the exception of check number 49606 for the period ending November 30, 2015. All members present voted yes, except Mr. Konkle, Mrs. Marriott and Mr. Ruffing voting no, the motion carried.

Approve general fund invoices

A motion was made by Mr. Snell and seconded by Mr. Hagemeyer for the approval to pay the Cafeteria Fund invoices for the period ending November 30, 2015. All members voted yes, the motion carried.

Approve cafeteria fund invoices

A motion was made by Mr. Snell and seconded by Mr. McCleary for the approval of the Capital Project Fund invoices for the period ending November 30, 2015. During discussions, a motion was made by Mr. Kaplan and seconded by Mr. Logue to table Capital Project Fund checks 1013 through 1020, pending further review. All members present voted yes, except Mr. Konkle, Mrs. Marriott and Mr. Ruffing voting no, the motion carried. A motion was made by Mr. Snell and seconded by Mr. Hagemeyer to approve the payment of the Capital Project invoices, excluding checks numbered 1013 through 1020, for the period ending November 30, 2015, until further review. All members present voted yes, except Mr. Konkle, Mrs. Marriott and Mr. Ruffing voting no, the motion carried.

Dr. Bowers presented a recommendation for the approval of:

 additions to the coaching staff for the 2015-2016 school year of Christian Atherhold, girls' basketball volunteer coach; Joshua Berwanger, elementary wrestling volunteer coach; Greg Fisher, elementary wrestling volunteer coach and Keith Johns, elementary wrestling volunteer coach, pending receipts of clearances, and

A motion was made by Mr. Hagemeyer and seconded by Mrs. Marriott to approve the recommendation. All members present voted yes, the motion carried.

Dr. Bowers presented a recommendation for the approval of student participation in festivals and tournaments as listed under agenda item VI-B-5(b). A motion was made by Mr. Konkle and seconded by Mrs. Marriott to approve the recommendation. A motion was made by Mr. Hagemeyer and seconded by Mr. Kaplan to table the FBLA State Conference in Hershey due to the cost of the event. The board discussed whether any fundraising was done to help offset the cost of the state conference. Mrs. Keiser conveyed that there is fundraising, but only for the regional FBLA Regional conference. Mr. Snell requested that fundraising be done as a group to help offset the cost of future FBLA events. Upon further discussion, Mr. Hagemeyer withdrew the motion to table the FBLA State Conference due to the timing of when final registration and conference fees are due. Following the deliberation, the President, Mr. Snell, called for the vote on the original motion. All members present voted yes, the motion carried.

Dr. Bowers presented a recommendation for the approval of an agreement between **The American National Red Cross** and the Montoursville Area School District for the use of the District's facilities as an emergency shelter during a disaster. Mr. Kaplan made a recommendation to have available over-night facilities on-site, in all buildings, in the event of an emergency. Dr. Bowers indicated he would discuss overnight provisions with the American Red Cross. A motion was made by Mr. Hagemeyer and seconded by Mr. Snell to approve the recommendation. All members present voted yes, the motion carried.

Dr. Bowers presented a recommendation for the approval of the acceptance of an EITC grant from **First Community Foundation Partnership** in the amount of \$4,426.91 to be applied toward the writing training costs at Montoursville Area High School. A motion was made by Mr. Konkle and seconded by Mrs. Marriott to approve the recommendation. All members present voted yes, the motion carried.
