PUBLIC COMMENT

The president, Mr. Snell, announced public comments would be received by the board, which would not to exceed three (3) minutes per person or a total period of thirty (30) minutes. **Mr. Dan Mathers** addressed the board regarding land development and finance matters. **Mr. Carl Wentzler** addressed the board regarding property taxes and social media. **Mr. Dave Shimmel** made remarks regarding the additions and renovations to Montoursville Area High School. **Ms. Lauri Steinbacher** addressed the board regarding Loyalsock Valley Elementary School and standardized testing. **Ms. Tara Crebs** shared that individuals were unable to hear the school board and public comments. Finally, **Ms. Karen Wright** made comments regarding a drug and alcohol education program.

Public Comment

Mr. Ruffing presented questions to Mr. Snell and Mr. McCleary regarding items that were approved at the December 7, 2015 school board meeting.

AGENDA ITEMS

A motion was made by Mr. Snell and seconded by Mr. Hagemeyer to approve a revision of school board policy 006, Meetings, for first reading. Following deliberation of the matter, the president, Mr. Snell, called for a vote on the motion. All members present voted yes, except Mr. Konkle, Mrs. Marriott, and Mr. Ruffing voting no, the motion carried.

Approve revised school board policy

A motion was made by Mr. Hagemeyer and seconded by Mrs. Johns to approve payment of invoices placed on the table for additional review during the December 7, 2015 school board meeting including, general fund check number 49606 and capital project fund checks numbered 1013 through 1020. Following deliberation of the matter, the President, Mr. Snell, called for a vote on the motion. All members present voted yes, the motion carried.

Approve payment of invoices

Mrs. Marriot presented a question to Mr. Snell regarding the amount of time board members have to deliberate on motions. Mr. Snell provided an explanation.

Mr. Konkle requested a copy of the agreement or scope of work for the value engineering study being complete by Bassett Engineering. Mr. Snell indicated it would be provided as requested.

Mr. Britt Bassett, **Bassett Engineering**, provided an update regarding the value engineering study on the additions and alterations to Montoursville Area High School. First he reviewed the team he assembled to conduct the study. Then Mr. Bassett highlighted the steps that had been taken and provided initial findings from the structural engineer, architect, HVAC engineer, sprinkler consultant, electrical engineer, and the site and civil engineer. He explained that the scope of project was to review the physical condition of existing space, then determine educational space requirements to ensure educational spaces meet the educational needs. Mr. Bassett announced his final report would be presented to the Board during the January 26, 2016 work session meeting. Finally, Mr. Bassett answered questions from board members.

Presentation by B. Bassett

Mr. Dick Castner, **Crabtree, Rohrbaugh and Associates**, provided an update regarding the additions and alterations to Montoursville Area High School. A copy of his presentation is attached to and made a part of these minutes.

Presentation by D. Castner

Mrs. Marriott indicated there may not have been discussion permitted prior to voting on a motion during the December 7, 2015 school board meeting. Mrs. Marriott then asked questions regarding the appointment of the school solicitor. The board deliberated the topic.

Mr. Ruffing made comments regarding the appointment of the solicitor.



CONSTRUCTION REPORT 5

SCHOOL BOARD MEETING

December 29, 2015

Montoursville Area High School Additions and Renovations Project Montoursville Area School District Stadium Project Loyalsock Valley Elementary School Water Service

High School Additions and Renovations

Since the school board meetings November 10 and December 7, additional progress has been made on Building Sections A and E (Tech Ed). Testing and monitoring of construction activity has been continuing through the process, including tasks relating to placing of backfill and placing of concrete footings, concrete strength testing and mortar strength testing for masonry and observation for steel erection. The masonry subcontractor has brought the Tech Ed masonry to bearing height and interior masonry partitions are 80% complete. Face brick is complete at Tech Ed. Roof joists and decking are installed at Tech Ed, as well as the concrete floor slab. Installation of roofing at the Tech Ed is complete except the animal lab. In Building Section A, footings are nearly complete and masonry is extending to lintel height, both at the perimeter and interior walls. Installation of underground plumbing and electrical in Building Section A is keeping pace with construction progress. Further construction in this building has been suspended by the school board as of the School Board Meeting held December 7. Written notice given to the contractors December 8, 2015. Limits of work in areas associated with the suspension are being coordinated with Bassett Engineering. The following activities are expected for the near future:

- 1. Install roof top HVAC units and gas-fired unit heaters in Tech Ed.
- 2. Install Animal Lab roofing at Tech Ed.
- 3. Continue installation of electrical panel back boxes in Tech Ed.
- 4. Continue installation of above-grade mechanical, plumbing and electrical rough-ins in Tech Ed.
- 5. Paint in-place mock-ups for approval and start application of block filler in Tech Ed.
- 6. Install aluminum window frames and glazing at Tech Ed.
- 7. Continue the shop drawing submittal process.
- 8. Provide winterization construction according to scope for the three-story addition.

Stadium Project

This project is now completed with no further punch list. Recent vandalism to the track is repaired.

Loyalsock Valley Elementary School Water Service RFP

Receipt of proposals took place, with Bassett Engineering submitting the only proposal. Total proposed fee \$36, 310. It appeared that all facets of the RFP were properly addressed within the proposal. Project awarded to Bassett Engineering during School Board Meeting held December 7, 2015. Bassett Engineering advised to submit appropriate contract form for review and execution by the school district.
