A meeting of the Montoursville Area School District Board of School Directors was held on January 12, 2016 in the Auditorium of the Montoursville Area High School, 100 North Arch Street, Montoursville, PA 17754. The president, Ronald E. Snell, called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

A motion was made by Mr. Ruffing and seconded by Mr. Konkle to turn off the school district video cameras recording the audience. Following deliberation of the matter the president, Mr. Snell, called for a roll call vote on the motion. Mr. Hagemeyer, No; Mrs. Johns, No; Mr. Kaplan, No; Mr. Konkle, Yes; Mr. Logue, No; Mrs. Marriott, Yes; Mr. McCleary, No; Mr. Ruffing, Yes; and Mr. Snell, No, the motion was defeated.

The president, Mr. Snell, called for a vote on the amendment. All members present voted yes, except Mr. Hagemeyer and Mr. Kaplan voting no, the amendment to the motion passed. The president, Mr. Snell, then called for a vote on the amended original motion. All members present voted yes, the amended original motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Konkle and seconded by Mr. Hagemeyer to approve the recommendation. Mr. Ruffing noted the retirements of Mr. Kurtz and Mr. Moore should be accepted with great reluctance. All members present voted yes, the motion carried.

Dr. Bowers presented a recommendation for the approval of the Montoursville Area High School Course Description Catalog for the 2016-2017 school year. A motion was made by Mrs. Marriott and seconded by Mr. Hagemeyer to approve the recommendation. All members present voted yes, the motion carried.

**Approval of Course Description Catalog**

Dr. Bowers presented a recommendation for the approval of approval of revised policy 006, Meetings, for the second reading. A motion was made by Mr. Kaplan and seconded by Mr. Hagemeyer to approve the recommendation. During deliberation a motion was made by Mr. Ruffing and seconded by Mr. McCleary to amend the motion, revising section 5, paragraph 1 of the policy to indicate "Regular Board meetings shall be public and shall be held at specified places at least once every two (2) months at times, dates, and places to be determined at the organizational meeting in December each year." Following deliberation of the amendment, the president, Mr. Snell, called for a vote on the amendment. All members present voted yes, the amendment carried. The president, Mr. Snell then called for a vote to approve the policy on second reading as amended. All members present voted yes, the motion to approve the amended policy on seconded reading carried.

**Approval of revised school board policy, as amended, on second reading**

A motion was made by Mr. Snell and seconded by Mr. Ruffing to change the school board meeting and work session meeting starting times for calendar year 2016 from 6:30 pm to 7:00 pm and authorize advertisement of the change. All members present voted yes, the motion carried.

**Approval of meeting start times**

Dr. Bowers presented a recommendation for approval to replace policy 007, Distribution, with policy 007, Policy Manual Access, on first reading. A motion was made by Mrs. Marriott and seconded by Mr. Ruffing to approve the recommendation. During deliberation a motion was made by Mr. Snell and seconded by Mrs. Johns to amend the motion to indicate two (2) printed policy manuals should be maintained in the district administrative offices. The president, Mr. Snell, called for a vote on the amendment to the motion. All members present voted yes, the amendment the original motion carried. The president, Mr. Snell, then called for a vote on the amended original motion. All members present voted yes, the amended original motion carried.

**Approval of school board policy, on first reading**

Dr. Bowers presented a recommendation for the approval of student participation in conferences and festivals as listed under agenda item VI-B-5(b). A motion was made by Mr. Konkle and seconded by Mrs. Marriott to approve the recommendation. All members present voted yes, the motion carried.

**Approve student participation**

Dr. Bowers presented a recommendation for the approval of an agreement between **Bassett Engineering Inc.** and Montoursville Area School District for services at Loyalsock Valley Elementary School Water System. A motion was made by Mr. Hagemeyer and seconded by Mr. Kaplan to approve the recommendation. All members present voted yes, except Mr. Konkle voting no, the motion carried.

**Approve agreement with Bassett Engineering**

#### **REPORT OF THE BUSINESS MANAGER**

Mr. Saul presented a recommendation for the approval of changes to the school bus contract with **Promised Land Bussing** revising van #25 from \$226.43 to \$356.15 per day and adding van #26 at \$186.77 per day, effective December 28, 2015. A motion was made by Mrs. Marriott and seconded by Mr. Snell to approve the recommendation. All members present voted yes, the motion carried.

**Approve school bus contract changes**

Mr. Saul presented for the Board's consideration of approval a request from J.C. Keefer, **Montoursville High School Football**, for use of the facilities at C.E. McCall Middle School to conduct a football banquet on January 31, 2016; a request from Vic Gorini, **Montoursville Girls Soccer**, for use of facilities at C.E. McCall Middle School to conduct a soccer banquet on January 31, 2016; and a request from Philip Buehrer, **Montoursville Rotary Club**, for use of the facilities at C.E. McCall Middle School to conduct a community blood testing program. A motion was made by Mr. Snell and seconded by Mrs. Marriott to approve the use of facilities requests. All members present voted yes, the motion carried.

### COMMITTEE REPORTS

#### Buildings & Grounds –

A motion was made by Mr. Kaplan and seconded by Mr. Logue to authorize payment to **Lecce Electric** for LED lighting that they had purchased for the construction project and to store the LED lights on pallets onsite in the basement of the high school to avoid storage penalties. Following deliberation a motion was made by Mr. Snell and seconded by Mrs. Marriott to amend the motion to store the lights in a place deemed appropriate by district administration. All members present voted yes, the amendment to the original motion carried. The president, Mr. Snell, then called for a vote on the amended original motion. All members present voted yes, the motion carried.

**Approve acceptance and storage of LED lights**

A motion was made by Mr. Kaplan and seconded by Mr. Logue to authorize **Bassett Engineering** along with **Crabtree, Rohrbaugh and Associates** to make a decision whether to move the present "power trunking" from the existing shops to the new tech building or install new "power trunking" in the new tech education building so there would be minimal disruption to students in shop classes. Following deliberation the president, Mr. Snell, called for a vote on the motion. All members present voted yes, the motion carried.

**Authorize evaluation of power trunking installation**

A motion was made by Mr. Snell and seconded by Mr. McCleary to extend the meeting by one (1) additional thirty-minute period. All members present voted yes, the motion carried.

**Approve meeting extension**

Mr. Britt Bassett, **Bassett Engineering**, provided an update regarding the value engineering study of the additions and renovations to Montoursville Area High School. Mr. Bassett reviewed the definition of value engineering, the value engineering concept plan, deficiencies noted in Crabtree, Rohrbaugh and Associates reports, construction costs, funding sources, past construction projects, the condition of existing facilities, construction contract process, and trade specific reports. Then Mr. Bassett answered questions from board members.

**Update from Bassett Engineering**




