Mr. Scott Cousin discussed potential cost saving measures for the Additions and Renovations to the Montoursville Area High School, which included the elimination of return air ducts and using the ceiling plenum for return air, as well as the elimination of terrazzo flooring in favor of using quartz tile flooring.
