Principal Report (D. Feerrar)

- Upcoming Events

Administrative Business (M. Emick)

- Reviewed and approved March 2019 Treasurer's report
 - Two outstanding 3-6-9 Expenses. One from Meghan M. for books. The other is the \$5 book fair classroom prize which will be distributed during the book fair.
 - Discussed the 3rd grade field trip. It seems that the 3rd grade teachers opted for tee shirts over a snack at the circus, as tee shirts were made and the permission slip indicated there would be no snack at the circus. Misty to get clarification.
 - Only item currently over budget was for the 4th grade concert cookies which was approved.
 - Misty will give Nicole Katie F.'s detailed "Field Trip and Student Allotment" report to ensure her expense records match Lyter PTO's records

 - Vicki resigned her current position and will not be returning to the board next year
 - Spring Fling Coordinator, Special Events Coordinator, and Fundraising Coordinator are open positions

- Open 2019-2020 Board Positions
 - Positions to be advertised in the Newsletter are the Fundraising Coordinator, Assistant Fundraising Coordinator, Special Events Coordinator, and Spring Fling Coordinator. (Note: following the meeting the Fundraising Coordinator position was filled and the Recording Secretary position is open).

Spring Fling (M. Emick)

 - Discussed and decided to offer selling prepaid Spring Fling Tickets at Loyalsock Valley and letting their PTO keep half of the prepaid ticket sales.
 - Meghan M. to reach out to the Loyalsock Valley PTO to see if they are interested in running a game and allowing prepaid tickets.
 - Considered selling wristbands for the rides, but decided against it as it may complicate the ticket sales and would be risky without having a rain date scheduled for the event.
 - Ticket posters may have been located in the basement

- Cousin Benny's was emailed, will follow up with a phone call if necessary

- For any new vendors, request to keep prices affordable (meaning nothing over \$5)

- Face paint supplies were also found, will have stand again this year
